**Bike Ride:** Arrive at Yorba Linda Regional Park at 8am (first dirt parking lot) and depart on bikes from there to the South end of Huntington Beach ending at Lifeguard Tower 3. This is a 21 mile bike ride, so make sure you are prepared to ride for 3-4 hours. We will stop twice for snacks and cool drinks.

**Bike Prep:** All bikes need to be tuned at least 1 week before the event by tuning your bikes at home (making sure tires are in good condition, chain is oiled, brakes work) or bringing them to one of the following:

**What to Bring and Wear:**

- Bike Helmet
- Red Shirt with shorts or pants that are not loose at the ankle (or able to tuck pant leg into sock)
- Backpack with 10 Essentials
- Water Bottle
- Optional - Towel (send with parents)
- Optional - Bathing Suit (send with parents)
